Important Things to Remember

Helmets are required and must be worn at all times! Remember to fill your water bottles. Students/children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult (parent or guardian) at all times.

Choose a ride distance that you are prepared to ride. If you have trained for and are riding the 100-mile route, please start early.

Obey the rules of the road and the laws and traffic regulations of the State of Indiana. Ride on the right side of the road.

Make sure you know how to properly signal for turns and do so appropriately.

Please stop at all stop signs, yield the right of way, and stay to the right unless you are passing another cyclist. Even though you may have the right of way, make sure you ride safely.

Always call out to riders as you pass them: "On your left" or "Passing." Never pass on the right.

Motorists may not be familiar with sharing the roadway with cyclists. Please do not ride three and four abreast, disregarding traffic on the roads.

Crossing railroad tracks is extremely dangerous. If it rains the tracks become slick. Cross with caution.

Cyclists often ride in groups: Do not stop and block the roadway, and do not stop and block intersections. If you need to stop during the ride, make sure to get safely off the road to the right.

Be aware of riders in front of you and watch for sudden stops. Be aware of riders behind you, and don't stop suddenly or without signaling.

Check your bicycle before leaving home to make sure it's safe and in good working order. Consider taking it in for a tune-up by a qualified bicycle mechanic.

Please bring your own spare tube, patch kit, pump, and basic tools for minor repairs.

SAG wagons are available for emergencies only. While SAG drivers may assist with emergency bicycle repairs such as flat tires, they are not bike mechanics and will not be carrying extra tubes or other supplies.

Be a courteous cyclist at all times!

This event will go forward, rain or shine.

CONSENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Release of Organizers and Sponsors: In signing this form for myself or named participant (if he/she is under 18 years of age), I accept and agree to the following statements:

- I understand that bicycle riding is a potentially hazardous activity, and I voluntarily participate in it of my own free will. In choosing to attend this event, I agree to assume all risks before, during and after this event.
- I acknowledge that I am in sound medical condition, capable of participating in this ride without risk to myself or others, and that I have no known medical condition that would endanger me or cause me to endanger others.
- I agree that I will be solely responsible for the condition of my bicycle and related equipment.
- I agree to abide by the rules of the road as well as the rules of the ride.
- I consent to the use of my name, photograph or likeness, voice and written responses in promotions and advertising materials.
- Understanding that risks exist, I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS THE ORGANIZERS, SPONSORS, COMMUNITIES, ORGANIZATIONS, MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS AND SUPPORT PERSONNEL, WHETHER INDIVIDUALS OR ORGANIZATIONS and all successors SINGLY OR COLLECTIVELY of all blame for any injury, misadventure, harm, loss or inconvenience suffered directly or indirectly as a result of taking part in this ride or any of the activities associated with the event.

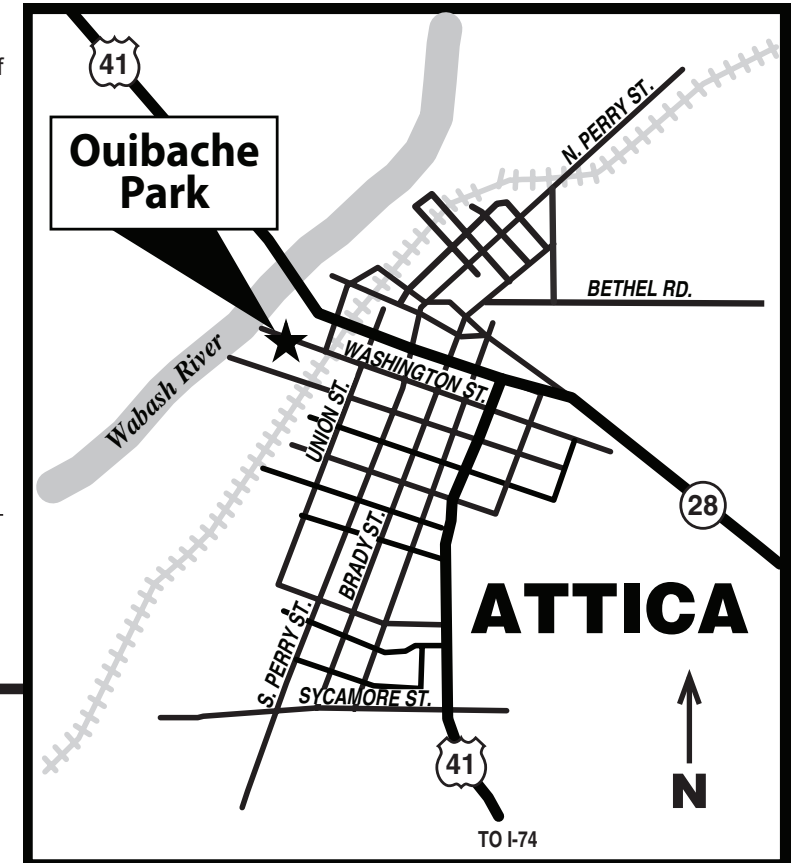
